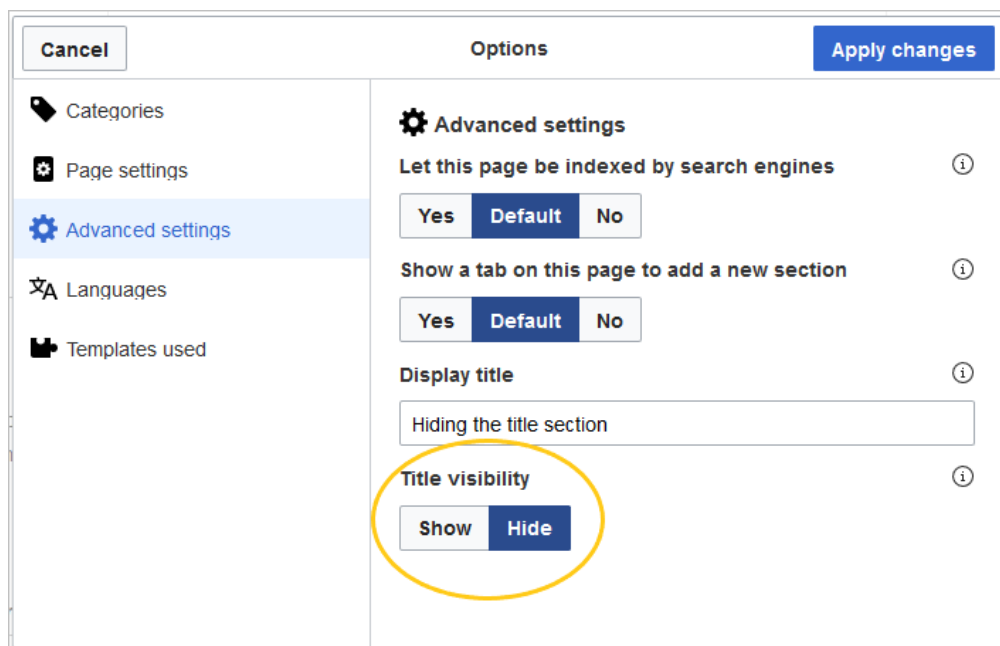

Usage

In VisualEditor, go to *Page options* > *Advanced settings*:



This adds the magic word `__HIDETITLE__` in the source code, usually at the top of the page. After saving the page, the page title is hidden in view mode.

Technical details

The extension **BlueSpiceHideTitle** enables hiding the title section of the page.
