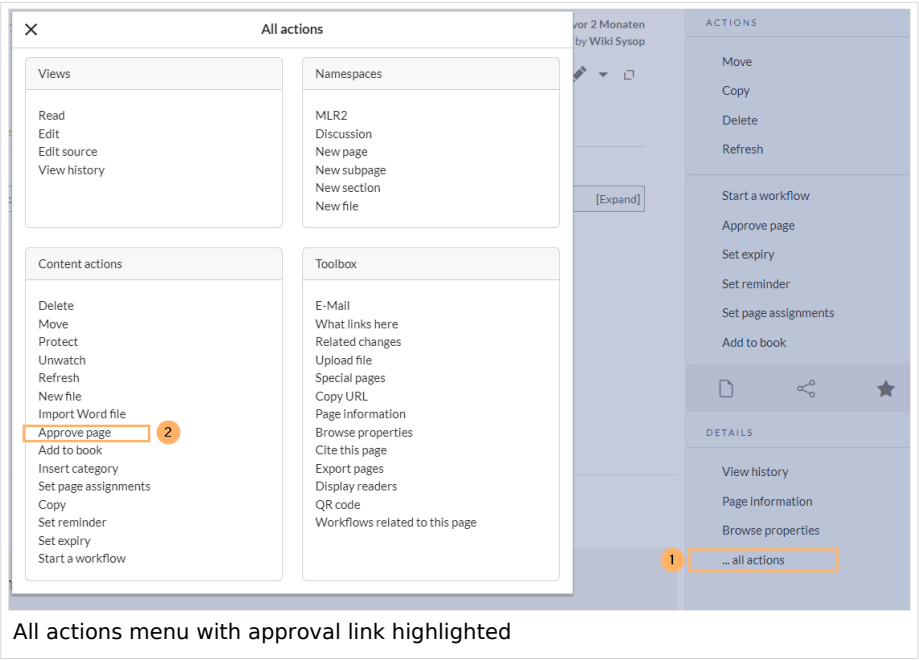
HideTitle enables hiding of the title on the page, if it's necessary.
