Naming conventions

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===Categories=== Generell unterscheiden wir bei der Klassifizierung von Seiten zwischen Kategorien und Attributen. Mit Kategorien wird die Seite an sich beschrieben. Am Beispiel Kunden kategorisieren wir jede Kundenseite mit dem Schlagwort "Kundendaten." Die Kategorie sammelt also alle Seiten, auf der sich Kundendaten befinden. When classifying pages, we generally differentiate between categories and properties. The page itself is described with categories. Using the example of customers, we categorize each customer page with the keyword "Customer data". The category therefore collects all pages on which customer data is located.
