The default page is hard to navigate because of cookie consent menu and focusable mobile menu.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Link can be deactivated in main menu for all users and can be ignored by admin users in the management menu.• Extension can be deactivated for on-premise installations or custom content can be loaded in iframe (customer is responsible for loading accessible content).
