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== Creating a page list for the export == The export list is defined in the wiki page that is shown as the <code>title</code> in the json-file. (In the example above, this is the page <code>MyPDF</code> .) The page <code>MyPDF</code> now needs to list all pages that will be exported to PDF. This list can be created with an [[SMW queries|SMW inline query]] (BlueSpice free) or with a [[Manual:Extension/DynamicPageList3|DPL3 list]] (BlueSpice free). Example of an SMW query to create an export for all pages in the categories <code>Process</do>

With every page impression, a part of these will be processed. For the case that there are lots of processes in the queue and there are relatively litte page impressions, the tasks will not be processed promptly. For this reason, the queue should be processed regularly by cronjob. Create a cronjob (Windows: "Scheduled task") depending on your operating system. The command to execute is: php <code>&lt;installpath-bluespice&gt;</code>/maintenance/runJobs.php "(Linux)" php.exe <code>&lt;installpath-bluespice&gt;</code>/maintenance\runJobs.php "(Windows)" Execute the cronjob every "'10 minutes'".
